

VOLUNTARY RIGHT TO BUY

EVIDENCE

As part of your Voluntary Right to Buy application, you will need to supply a range of documents supporting your application (aka `evidence`).

Below will outline the sorts of documentation we will need from you to process your application.

PLEASE NOTE: If we don't receive the correct evidence along with your application form, this will cause delays which could result in a VOID application.

1. PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION

This needs to be for all purchasers of the property and can include:

- Current signed passport
- Current full UK/ EU driving licence
- Resident Permit issued by the Home Office to EU Nationals
- Inland Revenue Tax Notification
- State Pension, Benefit Book or notification letter

2. PROOF OF CURRENT ADDRESS

This needs to be for all purchasers of the property and can include:

- Current full UK/ EU driving licence
- Utility bill issued with the last 3 months
- Local Authority tax bill
- Bank, Building Society or Credit Union statement from a UK lender
- State Pension, Benefit Book or notification letter

3. PROOF OF PREVIOUS TENANCIES

This needs to be for the lead tenant and should include any documentation from social landlords or social tenancies that you want included in your Voluntary Right To Buy discount.
